If you are looking for a new career, a change in scenery and a chance to travel, apply for one of the two positions open at International Headquarters in Austin, Texas. Visit the Society website for application and timelines.



Qualifications for Program/Membership Services Administrator include Master's degree or higher (or equivalent) and educational background in areas such as research skills, human relations, information systems, computer applications, technology, humanities, arts and sciences.

Qualifications for Communications Services Administrator include Master's degree or higher (or equivalent) and educational background in areas such as communications, English, journalism, administration and supervision, public relations and leadership.

The beginning salary range for these positions is \$54,500-\$55,500 depending on experience. Moving expenses to Austin, Texas, will be provided, not to exceed \$8,000. Other benefits include paid medical insurance, some dental coverage, free covered parking at Headquarters, and a 401(K) plan provided by the Society. Projected employment is August/September 2009.



Positions are open at International Headquarters in Austin, Texas.
